Mr. Councilperson Jan Vanderstelt,

It has come to my attention that you are actively seeking to engage non interested third parties about the events that took place at 91 Spring Street Brantford, Mohawk Domain.

My business partner has sent me communications received by you, attempting to engage him in dialog relating to the U.E. Mohawk Tax protest at 91 Spring Street.

If you would like to talk about these events, I am the only person you need to discuss this with, as I do possess limit power of attorney for the account. In what capacity did you attend my home, and did the I personally request that you attend? We asked months prior to these events if you represented the Mohawk peoples, and how, and if not how taxes are lawfully apply to them. You arrived and asked if we are your constituents, and indicated that we are on dangerous territory, I have had very positive talks with Phil Mccoleman about his own confusion about Mohawks being a part of his constituency, and his office has modified his mailers to reflect that new certainty. Jan, it is impossible and outrageous to assume that Mohawk at any level are constituents of your offices.

In fact you are lawfully bound to the U.E. Mohawk, the Canadian Government and those who take the Oath of Allegiance are Pledged to the Mohawk on via the Upper Canada Seal on the Haldimand Proclamation within The Grand River and Bay of Quinte. This is a trust that embodies the honor of the Crown.

The actions you and council did take to remove my home, was an act of anti-peace, and you and council have by your own actions become trustee de son tort for the benefit of the U.E. Mohawks.

As you know, my privacy is valued and must be protected. I claim this is a breach of my privacy, and I want you to continue our investigation but please do so with the law in mind.

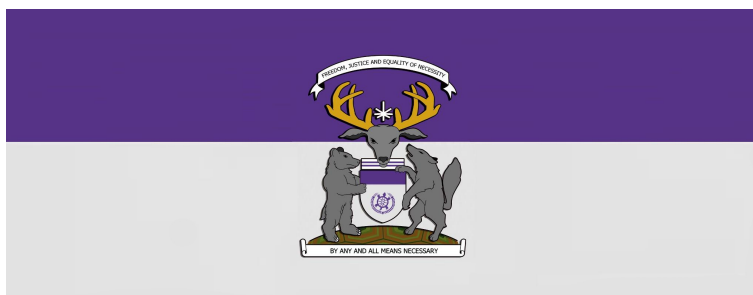
